- The apartment has a coded lock on the exterior door. Guests will receive a text message with the code upon the approval of their application. Guests who are unable to send/recieve texts, will receive a phone call.
- 2 Bedroom , 2 Bathroom. Due to current COVID-19 regulations, the apartment will be occupied by one family/pod at a time.
- At end of stay, all belongings must be removed, trash collected and put in provided bags.
- At the end of stay, guests must strip sheets off of the bed & put them along with used towels in the laundry baskets provided in the closet.
- Between guests, the apartment will be disinfected by trained staff/volunteers and beds will be made with clean linens.
- No parking available
- Maximum 4 night stay
- Wifi available. Network & password information will be on the welcome document on the counter in the apartment.
- Laundry is not provided in-unit. A laundromat is located within walking distance.
- Any maintenance issues must be immediately reported to hostess by text
- Hostess baskets with a few treats (snacks & waters) and practical items (basic toiletries) are provided in each bedroom.
- Any food in the cabinets in the kitchen is available for guests.
- No alcohol or recreational drugs (including marijuana) of any sort may be brought into our unit. We will immediately request that you leave if this is evident.
- No smoking or vaping of any sort allowed in our units.
