Mass General social workers are licensed mental health clinicians who provide short-term individual, couple, family and group therapy.

We can help you with:

- Coping with illness, injury, treatment and recovery

- Abuse, neglect, violence and other safety issues
- Job, school or other life stresses

If you get your primary medical care at Mass General and meet certain other criteria, you may qualify.
