HOPE LODGE GUIDELINES



REFERRING PARTNERS & GUESTS



PATIENT PROTECTION

Masks are required inside Hope Lodge at all times except when guests are in their private rooms and when eating in the dining room.



PHYSICAL DISTANCING

Physical distancing in all common areas of Hope Lodge – six foot rule. Signage is posted throughout the building showing the limits on number of people in each area.



MEALS

Kitchen and dining area times may be assigned to ensure physical distancing. Dinner programs, activities or entertainment may be limited due to safety protocols.



COVID-19 VACCINE

It is strongly recommended that all guests be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 prior to arrival at Hope Lodge. Patients and caregivers who are unvaccinated will be required to provide a negative COVID test taken no more than 48 hours prior to their arrival.



ALTERNATIVE LODGING

Any patient or caregiver who tests positive for COVID-19, develops symptoms suggestive of COVID-19 and/or who has a known exposure to someone with COVID-19 during their stay will be required to leave the Hope Lodge premises immediately. The referring partner and Hope Lodge teams will work together to provide information regarding alternative lodging options.

As we resume Hope Lodge operations, we are dedicated to remaining open to provide key access to cancer care for our guests. This requires new and changing processes and procedures based on the scientific knowledge and advice of experts in oncology, infection control and the CDC.
